“Immune Refocusing: A Novel Method of Elicitation of High Titer Neutralizing Antibodies in a Lentivirus Animal Model for HIV Vaccine Development.”

Data to be presented summarizes the development of a novel immunogen capable of stimulating high titer, cross reactive neutralizing antibodies, the persistence and enhancement of these targeted neutralizing antibody responses following exposure to wild type virus, and the efficacy of neutralizing antibodies in the reduction of lentiviral induced disease.
