



Call for Proposals for the 2009 Undergraduate Student Support Program

The Center for Integrated BioSystems at Utah State University wishes to announce a call for proposals for the undergraduate Center for Integrated BioSystems Research (uCIBR) Program for 2009. If you are an undergraduate student who is conducting biotechnology research in a Utah State University laboratory, you may be eligible for financial support.

The undergraduate student support program offered by the CIB supports students who demonstrate exceptional promise. The application packet consists of a one-page description, detailed budget, Curriculum Vitae, uCIBR application form, and a mentor recommendation form. An electronic copy of all items listed above must be submitted to jparnell@biology.usu.edu by 5:00 p.m. Friday, February 27, 2009.

All complete and on-time proposals will be evaluated by a panel of senior faculty. Awards will be announced by March 20, 2009.
